This is 5-year old Kyle Lagrasso. You might have heard about his story already on every major network. Brandon and I are friends of Kyle and his family and he plays on the US Golf Tour with Brandon. Kyle is the little boy from PA that had cancer on both eyes when he was two. The doctors gave Kyle 3-months to live and had to remove his left eye to stop the spreading of the cancer. He battled the illness and he is now perfectly healthy and has become one of the best 6-year old golfers in PA and on the US Kids Tour. Remember he only plays with vision out of one eye. Kyle is one of the coolest, down to earth kids you will ever meet. At the age of 5 Kyle is already making a difference with his foundation to help cure **retinoblastoma**. Brandon and I have partnered up with Kyle and his family to make a difference as well. Brandon has joined Kyle's Pars For Charity www.parsforcharity.org which Brandon donates money based on how many pars he makes at each event. Kyle was given the Peggy Kirk Bell Award at Pinehurst last year at the US Kids World Golf Championship for the most influential child.

Kyle has already been through more life threatening obstacles in his life at the age of five than anyone I know. If you have kids take a deep breathe and thank God for how lucky you are to have great, healthy kids. I do every day.
